Minutes from the Minister

I have some news for everybody that is both good news and a need for much prayer. Last Wednesday an application for a government grant was submitted jointly by the parish and the Parish Centre Preschool. The grant is for the building of a new building for the Parish Centre Preschool to occupy and the parish would take over the current premises and convert them to our parish office. The application has been quite involved and we have been guided by professional people along the way.

The new building would be on the grounds of St Andrew's at the base of the current playground. I have taken the opportunity to put up some of the preliminary designs on the notice board at the door of St Andrew's for you to have a look. (I need to stress these are preliminary, we have not even started the process for a DA from the council, there is much work still to do) I want to publicly thank all those involved in the application who have got us to this point.

The new building would be a boon for the preschool. A purpose built facility that meets best current practise and it would allow the preschool to expand. A real opportunity for our preschool to expand their ministry. It would also be a boon for us as we would get premises for our parish office on the grounds of St Andrew's.

What do we need now? Prayer and a lot of it. We need to be praying that the grant application is successful. It is now in the hands of the Department of Education. Let's pray that it is successful. This grant has seemed to some of us a real answer to the prayers we have said for our new parish office. Please join with me in praying for this grant application, the preschool, our parish office and the future. To that end I am calling a prayer meeting for next Saturday at 8am at St Andrew's. Come along and join us in prayer for the application, the preschool and those who will make the decision about the grant application.
